## **Student Essay Contest**

The <u>Coalition for Integrity</u>, an anti-corruption and good government non-profit, non-partisan organization, announces an essay contest for students on: "Attacking Corruption and Promoting Integrity in the United States and around the Globe." Eligibility is open to any student attending a college or university in the United States or any U.S. citizen or permanent resident attending a college or university outside the United States. Contestants may be undergraduate students, graduate students, or students in a professional school. They can have any disciplinary or professional school background relevant to understanding and ameliorating the problem of corruption.

Essays should be written in English and be no more than 10,000 words, although shorter essays are welcome. Writers should include a note from their college or university registrar attesting either to their current student status or to their graduation in 2018. Submissions must be made to <a href="mailto:administration@coalitionforintegrity.org">administration@coalitionforintegrity.org</a> by midnight on July 31, 2018.

Essays will be judged by a panel made up of Directors of the Coalition for Integrity based on the quality of the research and the originality and realism of the proposals. The Coalition especially encourages essays on issues with a US focus, but papers with a comparative or international focus are also welcome. Essay writers can define "corruption" as they wish, but they should justify their approach. The student writing the winning essay will receive \$2,000 and will be invited to attend Coalition for Integrity Award Dinner in Washington, D.C.
